### OATH Confidentiality Statement

I agree not to divulge any client or case information obtained in the course of my association with OATH to any person. I further agree not to publish, and generally not to make public, any personal information regarding persons who have received services that would enable identification of individuals.

I recognize that unauthorized release of confidential information may make me subject to a civil action and may lead to termination of my membership in OATH.

I understand the exceptions to client rights to confidentiality as mandated by law in the following instances:

- If the client threatens grave bodily harm or death to another person or to him/herself
- If a court order is issued
- If child abuse, sexual abuse or neglect with a minor (not previously reported)
- If the abuse of dependent adults or the elderly is suspected

It is further agreed that based on a victim centered approach all members of OATH will clear any requests for publicity that would include a trafficking victim through the OATH Administrator.

I agree to discuss any concerns, questions, or exceptions to confidentiality as listed above with the OATH Administrator or OATH Victim Advocate.

I have read the above and acknowledge my understanding of it and will abide by this professional standard in practice, irrespective of termination of my affiliation with the OATH.
